Policy Matters Ohio is a Cleveland based, grant-funded research organization that investigates and analyzes issues of importance to working Ohio families. Our studies include quantitative analysis of employment and unemployment, work and wages, minimum wage, budget and tax issues, economic development, trade, and related issues.

The intern work will involve quantitative and qualitative research; legislative educational strategies; participation with coalitions; assistance with workshops and presentations, and clerical tasks as necessary. Over the summer, PMO interns compiled and manipulated data detailing trends in loan defaults; conducted web searches for national studies; compiled and manipulated wage for a study on state spending trends; reviewed case law relating to a proposed tax and expenditure limitation; and worked with IRS data as part of investigation of the impact of income taxes on migration.

This is not a paid position, but supervision will be provided by individuals with extensive experience in economic analysis. Interns are encouraged to seek credit for independent study for work undertaken here. Interns are frequently cited as co-authors on reports and participate fully in PMO local and legislative events.
